IA Update:

COVID data update for Columbia County, Oregon is firmly in the middle of the "4th Surge" of the Pandemic. Hospitalized patients are younger and fewer underlying health conditions. Columbia County risk status continues to be under the Extreme. All Oregonians over age 16 are now eligible for the vaccine, and 12-15-year-olds will likely be next in the coming weeks. There is a new Emergency Broadband Benefit available to folks on Medicaid. Emergency Broadband Benefit Program is a Federal Communications Commission (FCC) program that provides a temporary monthly discount. If eligible, you can receive: Up to a \$50/month discount on your broadband service and associated equipment rentals, Up to a \$75/month discount if your household is on qualifying Tribal lands, a one-time discount of up to \$100 for a laptop, tablet, or desktop computer (with a copayment of more than \$10 but less than \$50) Only one monthly

Annual Community Health Improvement Plan Update: Nancy Knopf & Teresa Lavagnino They provided an update of the CHIP as part of the annual report. They shared the goals, benchmarks, and targets for priority areas as identified in the RHIP. Progress included services and activities toward reaching the metrics or indicators for health priority areas identified in the CHIP. They will continue to seek feedback from CAC members as needed.
