Columbia County Community Advisory Council (CAC) Summary Monday, February 3, 2020, 3:30-5:30 pm

AGENDA ITEMS:

Members opened the meeting at 3:36 pm- January minutes were not approved because there was not a quorum.

CCO 2.0 and CACs: What's New? The group reviewed the handout from Oregon Health Authority's Transformation Center that summarized changes in requirements for CACs with the CCO 2.0 contracts. The group integrated a more general discussion around equity and inclusivity work for the CAC.

CCO and CAC Community Engagement and Health Equity: The group did not complete a formal SOAR (Strengths, Opportunities, Aspirations, Results) analysis since the conversation was weaved into the CCO 2.0 discussion. However, many opportunities to work on equity were discussed and noted and the group agreed to have the notes written up under "opportunities" to bring back to the CAC when more members are present.

Innovator Agent (IA) Update and Community Updates: The IA gave an update on the public charge ruling and the REAL ID Act. The IA also reminded the CAC of the two recorded Transformation Center webinars that highlight the main changes for CACs with CCO 2.0. Oregon's Metric and Scoring Committee is discussing a quality metric related to health equity and obesity prevention. CCO staff will meet in March for a CCO 2.0 conference.

Other Updates: CPCCO will attend the Survive and Thrive Resource Fair, organized by the Suicide Prevention Task Force, with a few volunteers from the CAC. The Advisory Council/Member Engagement Coordinator position has been posted. Several community events were mentioned, including many activities at the St Helens library.
