

Tillamook County Community Advisory Council – Summary

Wednesday, January 3rd, 2024 1:00-3:00pm

AGENDA ITEMS

Meeting called to order at 1:01pm by Chair. Went through housekeeping slides for virtual meetings and interpretation. Approved agenda and last month's minutes.

CAC Learning Theme: Teresa and Judy presented a review of our Learning Theme work in 2023, in each county. We worked in Mural to determine what we would like to focus on this year. Some suggestions included flex benefit information, addressing tribal concerns, focusing on helping seniors and survivors of domestic and sexual violence navigate systems.

Regional Health Assessment Update: Heather shared out the update on the Story Collection project. She reviewed the seven topics that were identified by the Story Collection and gave us a little sneak preview of what we will be discussing at the February CAC. Everyone will have an opportunity to vote on what they feel are the priorities. Please invite others as this is a community conversation!

SHARE: Nancy and Teresa reviewed the four proposed SHARE projects. Clatsop Community action for the Hilltop Apartments and Rapid Rehousing Program, Helping Hands, for the Re-entry program (in Clatsop and Tillamook Counties), and CAT for the Healthy Homes program.

IA Update/ Actualización IA: Belle shared that 5 out of 6 people will keep OHP after redeterminations. There is now a mobile app for the ONE system. The waiver sessions continue and folks are encouraged to attend.
