AGENDA ITEMS:

Meeting called to order at 3:05pm by Chair. Minutes and agenda approved with one minor correction.

Staff reviewed the SOAR (Strengths, Opportunities, Aspirations, and Results) process with the group. Input from group will be used in CCO Health Equity plan. Results are determined by OHA and CCO requirements. Themes: accommodations for people who are hearing impaired, equal access to resources for all, addressing transportation, having multiple people representing different demographics. We discussed youth voice, tribal involvement, outreach to the LGBTQ population and Spanish-speaking population.

Year-end Review: we identified themes as well as who to involve. Themes included: social isolation and mental health, local behavioral health services, accurate vaccination information, food security (especially for children and elderly), and disabilities. We discussed some CCO-funded programs. A member is an unofficial advocate within Tillamook County Wellness around disability and disability rights.

IA update: We are in Phase 1; if all goes well, we enter Phase 2 on June 5th. OHA created a new public health indicators dashboard to share reopening progress.

CWIF applications open in June and the group discussed possible applicants. Some of the projects suggested are currently being funded by the CCO or CareOregon.

New business/Announcements: We will continue the two meeting per month format through June. June meetings will be on 6/10 and 6/24. We will assess July after we have more info on the COVID situation.
