

Columbia County Community Advisory Council Summary

Monday, August 5, 2019, 3:30-5:30 pm

AGENDA ITEMS:

Chair opened the meeting at 3:51 pm and the agenda and July minutes were approved.

Community Wellness Investment Fund (CWIF) Grant Review: Nancy updated the CAC on the Community Wellness Investment Fund process. The grant is currently open for proposals through the end of August. A group of CAC members volunteered to do the review.

CAC Learning Theme: Weighted voting results from the last meeting on learning themes was reported with a discussion. Given the current opportunities and relevance of both issues, the CAC voted to approve a combined theme of housing and transportation for the next 6 months for the CAC learning series.

Innovator Agent (IA) Update: Joell gave an update on the CCO 2.0 contracting process. CPCCO was the only CCO awarded a contract for this region and passed all 6 parts of the application. The IA Update handout contains links to the award decisions and details of the applications open to the public. Rules Advisory Committee public meetings will be held from now through January 2020 to provide input on proposed rules for CCO contracts. CCO incentive metrics for 2020 were released and shared.

Community Updates: SAFE has support groups for teen and folks over 50. Head Start is recruiting families. Community Action's housing project opened and they are looking for new project opportunities. Other community flyers were shared.

There was no formal adjourning of the meeting due to the potluck.
