1. Finance Committee

a. September 2022 YTD Financial Report

2. Executive Committee

Moving to a Governance and Compliance Committee would preserve the current functions of both the Executive and Compliance Committees as is and absorb/disband the Nominating Committee, giving those responsibilities to the Governance and Compliance Committee.

3. Network & Quality Committee

4. Regional Housing Impact Fund - Helping Hands Re-Entry Outreach Center – \$360,000 Summary: Helping Hands Re-Entry Outreach Center is nearly finished with a multi-year effort to the 2nd floor of the *Tillamook Hope Center*, adding 40 transitional and emergency shelter beds. This funding will support the necessary remaining work to bring the building up to FEMA and other safety codes needed to complete the project.
