2. Nominating Committee

Summary: The Nominating Committee recommends additional two-year terms of office for existing Directors and recommends the Slate of Officers to serve one-year terms. All terms coincide with the calendar year.

3. Grant Request/Other

a. Food Roots Equity Program: \$40,000

Summary: This project will help increase the awareness of opportunities through the creation and implementation of a Local Food Equity Outreach Plan, with materials in both English and Spanish, while also increasing accessibility to those facing transportation barriers.

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b. Tillamook Family Counseling Center: $68,842
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Summary: This proposal will add a full-time (1.0 FTE) Peer Support Specialist (PSS) to partner with TFCC's existing Mobile Crisis and Crisis/Emergency Services response for Tillamook County. This position will expand current services to include both evening and partial weekend availability. In addition, this position intends to broaden TFCC's capacity to engage and communicate about the role of peers to the Latinx community in the county, especially to help reduce the stigma attached to crisis services.

c. Community Mental Health Pilot Program: \$300,000

Summary: This proposal would augment the behavioral health staff for each of our three Community Mental Health Programs (CMHP) for two years. The new staff would be deployed as local 1.0 FTE care coordinators to address frequent challenges and barriers to members remaining stabilized in their communities, using Flex resources for housing, benefit advocacy, and other SDOH needs. **ACTION: Move to accept recommendations for funding.**
