Meeting called to order at 4:32pm. All participants introduced and welcomed.

The April Agenda & Minutes from 1-2-2024, 2-6-2024 and 3-5-2024. CAC asked to entertain a motion to accept the **agenda** as written. Staff suggested changing the order and having the Health Right Group Uncoupling be first to accommodate Presenter's schedule. Motion made and seconded. Approved 5-0. **Minutes** from Jan 2, Feb 6 & March 5, 2024 were presented. A motion to accept as written was made and seconded. Approved 5-0.

New Member Election: 2 potential new members were discussed. Both have completed their paperwork and attended 2 meetings. Motion was made and seconded to approve their membership in the CAC. Approved 5-0.

Hybrid Meeting Housekeeping: A quick overview of the Translation process was made.

Charter Adoption: Staff reviewed the March 5, 2024 discussion regarding the Charter and asked if anyone had questions or changes. None were offered. A motion to accept the Charter with no changes was made and approved 5-0.

NWOHA Update: NWOHA new staff member joined the NW Oregon Housing Authority in November of 2023. They ae currently working to create a team of dedicated people to serve the 3-county population. He would like to see more innovative and inclusive ideas/programs put into place in all 3 counties. He discussed some of the issues they are tackling ex: deferred maintenance on properties, identifying which properties have debt and developing strategies for paying the debt down, rebuilding partnerships/relationships and maintaining them with local groups, working on the waitlists for housing assistance, having project-based voucher programs, finding a way to get the Owens Adair II project grading & erosion issue moving forward and having a customer facing staff. He encouraged people to contact him if they had any ideas, questions or needed to be updated on projects.

Learning Theme Proposal: Staff reviewed all the information from the 3 counties and have come up with a theme for 2024: **Active Community Building** by promoting connections, relationships , & community. Each county will have a focus and sub themes. Clatsop County's sub themes are: building relationships, healthy trauma informed communications and working through conflict as we work towards social justice and social change. These will be discussed throughout the year.

Innovator Agent Update: The Innovator Agent for OHA Updated us on the following:

- 1. Reviewed the HRSN 11-15 Waiver regarding Climate Resources for OHP Members that was rolled out March 1, 2024. Who qualifies and how to apply.
- 2. Discussed upcoming webinars about the unwinding of Covid-19.
