AGENDA ITEMS:

Meeting opened at 3:05pm by Chair. Agenda and minutes approved, with the correction of one typo. Nancy explained the CWIF process.

CWIF Presentations: Three organizations presented CWIF proposals: Tillamook County Women's Resource Center, Rinehart Clinic, and CASA. All three were well received and CAC asked several questions and discussed at length, then reviewed and rated the applications.

CHA/CHIP Update:

Nancy gave a brief update on the CHA/CHIP process and on the story collection. The deadline to collect the stories is now November 17, giving us a little more time. There will be a workshop in December to begin to review the results.

Incentive Funds Update:

Heather presented on the upcoming OHP and You. It will be eight sessions on Tuesdays, starting 9/18 at TBCC and there will be incentives for high attendance. After this pilot, we expect to roll it out to other counties.

We discussed the suicide prevention event for 9/20. We watched the trailer for the movie.

Explanation of quarterly focus: CPCCO recognizes that suicide has a significant impact on health and wellbeing of individuals and our communities.
