How does GOBHI's foster care program differ from ODHS foster care?

GOBHI has a license with Oregon's Department of Human Services to provide foster care. This license allows GOBHI to provide care for youth in the foster care system in both long-term and short-term contexts.

The youth in GOBHI's Therapeutic Foster Care program struggle with a variety of behavioral and mental health challenges. These youth come to GOBHI because our parents are well-trained and well-supported to handle the challenges that arise.



GOBHI Therapeutic Foster Care Program

- 63 Behavioral Rehabilitation Services Homes Statewide
- 8 Homes have siblings placed.
- 2024 GOBHI's Average Monthly Served 53
 - O Average # in full time placement 42
- GOBHI Home Retention in 2023 85%





For Foster Youth:

- A stable and affirming home environment
- Support from foster parents and staff, using both a strengths-based approach and Collaborative Problem Solving®
- Weekly skill building sessions
- 11 hours of interventions
- Connection to mental health, physical health and specialty care services
- Advocacy for their educational needs

For Foster Parents:

- Case manager assigned to each home through a youth's placement
- Reimbursement to help cover the cost of caring for the foster youth
- Paid relief care (both planned and crisis) for families providing full-time care
- 24/7 support through an on-call phone number
- Weekly skill building for youth placed in BRS
- Initial and ongoing training specific to the needs of the youth we serve
