AGENDA ITEMS:

Meeting called to order at 3:05pm by Chair. Agenda and minutes approved, with the correction of one typo.

CWIF Funds: Nancy announced that all three Tillamook County CWIF applications have been approved. Funds are pending and will be issued shortly.

CHA/CHIP and Survey Update:

Nancy gave a brief update on the CHA/CHIP process/survey. The deadline to collect the stories is now November 17, giving us a little more time. There will be a workshop in December to begin to review the results. CAC attendees completed the survey.

Incentive Funds Update:

Heather presented on the upcoming OHP and You. It will be eight sessions on Tuesdays, starting 9/18 at TBCC and there will be incentives for high attendance. After this pilot, we expect to roll it out to other counties.

Quarterly Focus: Suicide Awareness and Prevention

Explanation of quarterly focus: *CPCCO recognizes that suicide has a significant impact on health and wellbeing of individuals and our communities. We value the collaboration of all our stakeholders, including our members and community partners, to create a healthier Tillamook County.
