

Tillamook County Community Advisory Council

Wednesday, November 13, 2019, 3:00 -5:00 pm

AGENDA ITEMS:

Meeting called to order at 3:02pm by Chair. Agenda and November minutes approved; IA Update was inadvertently left off agenda, so that was added.

SRCH:

Heather presented info on the Sustainable Relationships and Community Health (SRCH) grant, a partnership led by the Tillamook Family Health Centers to address preventable disease. The 1-year grant will work with programs across the state to create a common testing/screening process and referral pathway for diabetes, and coordinate between the community and clinical partners. Partners include CPCCO, Tillamook County Wellness, TFHC, OSU Extension, Adventist Health, Rinehart Clinic and the YMCA.

CASA: Kari Rieck and Vanessa Genens from CASA presented about the work they are doing in Tillamook County, thanks to CWIF funds from the CCO. CWIF funds have provided more materials and time for training and community outreach, especially around incorporating ACES principles into all intersections of the work. CASA covers both Lincoln and Tillamook County, but the Tillamook CWIF funds stay in Tillamook County.

Innovator Agent Update:

Joell reviewed update materials, including Readiness Review results for the 14 remaining CCOs. Public Charge policy was supposed to go into effect on October 15th; it's currently tied up in the courts. There is a new CHA/CHIP guidance document, and the Oregon Health Policy Board's Health Equity Committee has developed an agency-wide definition of Health Equity. Joell summarized it eloquently as "helping people furthest from opportunity to achieve the same health outcomes as everyone else." She also provided a Tillamook County specific data sheet from Children First for Oregon, which we reviewed.

New business/Announcements:

Member announced that the City of Tillamook has been meeting every two weeks about community impact of homelessness. For a future agenda, it was suggested that we discuss health equity and homelessness.
