

Clatsop County Community Advisory Council Minutes

Tuesday, March 5, 2019, 5:00-7:00 pm

Chair called the meeting to order at 5:00. Agenda and February minutes were approved. Group reviewed the Charter and no changes were suggested. Members signed and submitted Conflict of Interest forms.

Nancy Knopf was present via phone and did a presentation on the CAC Best Practices framework that has been developed over the last year and a half. There was a discussion about funding for assisters, and places it would be very useful to have them, such as places where people are incarcerated, to meet people “where they are.”

Recruitment: Chair will reach out to local City Council members. Romy will continue to try to connect with Foster Club. There is a Co-Chair position open on the CAC, as well as a position on the Regional CAC.

Joell Archibald was unable to do her OHA Transformation Center website presentation, due to technical issues; it has been moved to the April meeting. She provided updates about the Community Health Improvement Plan (CHIP) and the State Health Improvement Program (SHIP), and provided links (which shall be emailed out to the group) on some other issues. There was a suggestion to bring a discussion about health modernization to the CAC.

April’s meeting will include Joell’s presentation, a debrief of the upcoming RCAC, and a discussion of CCO 2.0.
