

## *Tillamook County Community Advisory Council*

### **AGENDA ITEMS:**

Meeting called to order at 3:06pm by Chair. At the meeting's start, we didn't have a quorum, so we saved the business pieces of the meeting until later.

### **CPCCO Portal:**

Anna Lynch from CareOregon came to show us the new member portal, where members can access benefit info and other resources.

**Story Collection (housing):** Nancy and Heather presented info from the Story Collection project with an emphasis on housing (per CAC request). We reviewed the narratives and identified themes.

**OHA Decision:** Columbia Pacific CCO has been awarded a 5-year contract by the Oregon Health Authority. We will be the only CCO in the three-county region. As we move through the process, we will provide updates. Mimi suggested bringing out CPCCO staff to discuss the Behavioral Health piece, which we took over in June.

**IA Update:** Joell provided an update on additional OHA issues, including that Tillamook County Public Health has been granted a one-year SRCH grant (Sustainable Relationships for Community Health). This will involve public health, the CCO and community partners addressing chronic disease rates at the community level. It will support Tillamook Wellness work on reducing diabetes in Tillamook County.

**Business matters:** We approved the agenda, the June minutes, and voted in our new Co-Chair.

### **New business/Announcements:**

The new Mobile Van is having a ribbon cutting ceremony on August 7<sup>th</sup> at the fairgrounds. A member has been researching programs that provide support to loved ones of people with behavioral health issues. The CAC voted to support a Lights of Hope event on September 14, which will raise local awareness of addiction and offer resources and info. The group requested info from the Story Collection. There are two pieces of legislation in the City of Tillamook regarding tobacco use. member will email this to Romy to share, along with the work that the City of Tillamook is currently doing to address homelessness.
