Initial Criteria		If yes	If no
1.	Does the member have a diagnosis of OUD?	Continue to #2	Do not approve
2.	Is there rationale, supported by clinical documentation, of a reason why generic Suboxone tabs or films can't be used?*	Continue to #3	Do not approve
3.	Approve for 12 months		

\*Zubsolv is formulary only for the purposes of covering the first 30 days of MAT without prior authorization to comply with Oregon law. Continuation after 30 days will be scrutinized for medical rationale of why generic buprenorphine/naloxone products cannot be used. **There are many manufacturers of generic suboxone tabs and films and all possible alternatives should be exhausted before Zubsolv is considered.** Therapy changes may be required.

Buprenorphine 2 mg tabs	12 per day
Buprenorphine 8 mg tabs	4 per day
<b>Generic Suboxone Tabs</b>	
Buprenorphine/naloxone 2/0.5	90 per month
Buprenorphine/naloxone 8/2	4 per day

Buprenorphine/naloxone 2/0.5	90 per month
Buprenorphine/naloxone 4/1	4 per day
Buprenorphine/naloxone 8/2	1 per day
Buprenorphine/naloxone 12/3	2 per day
